The Institution is located at the heart of the Golden City which the tri lingual junction of AP, Karnataka and Tamilnadu where people of varied religions, culture, Language coexist. This place is famous for the national organisation BGML, BEML and NIRM.

Admissions

SBMJC provides a platform for the admission of every eligible student with desire of higher education and facilitates a favourable environment for learning to the diverse group of Students.

Accessibility

Since it is one of the best colleges offering UG at present PG at the same place and easily accessible as there are no geographical constraints. Students can easily travel through any means of transport.

Resource persons

As the KGF is 70 km to Bangalore by train and 90 km by road ways only Resource Persons from the NIRM, ISRO, DRDO, IISc, Universities and other institutions had been invited as resource persons for the seminars, conferences and guest lectures.

Examination Centre and venue

The location and a well maintained infrastructure made SBMJC one of the most referred Examination Centres for University Examinations and CET examinations. Open Auditorium, auditorium and Conference Hall are used by Police Department, Revenue Department during elections for training the officers, Computer lab is used for training programme TALP for PUC faculty at District level, Jain Community functions and for other trainings.

Locational Disadvantages

First generation learners

Once KGF was called as Indian England, but most of the people are illiterate and economically backward. After the closure of BGML most of the people go out of station for daily labour and their children come under first generation learners, parents doesn't give proper guidance on the education to their children and students also don't take education in a serious way, which is the basic for their career, this is one of the locational disadvantage.

The College had taken steps to overcome this disadvantage by providing counselling during the admission in choosing the subject, career guidance, personality development, skill development courses and campus recruitment is conducted.

Dust (Cyanide) Polluted Area

Till 2000 BGML was working and cyanide mixed sand was dumped like a hill, this sand pollute the air and cause various lungs problems this one of the major locational disadvantage. As per the instructions of District Judge, SBMJC-KGF students had planted more than 1124 saplings on the dump on 11-08-2017.

Locational Advantage of the Institute to the Neighbourhood Community
