2. The last date for obtaining permission for re-admission to II semester is **on or before 26.01.2019**
3. Principals are requested to make admissions for the approved course/s strictly in accordance with the Eligibility condition and also as per the sanctioned intake for each course.
4. The Principals should consider the marks cards of the qualifying exams of the recognized Boards only. The list of recognized Boards is available in BU University Website i.e. [www.bnu.ac.in](http://www.bnu.ac.in) Any marks card other than notified shall not be considered.



5. Regulations Governing the Choice Based Credit System (Semester Scheme) in the Undergraduate Programmes in the Faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce of BU shall be followed for the current academic year 2018-19.
6. Principals are requested to allot the invigilation work to the teachers of major subjects such as Commerce, Management, English, Mathematics, Economics etc., in the beginning of the theory examination and relieve them immediately for evaluation work.
7. Principals are further requested to compulsorily collect the evaluation attendance certificates from all the teachers who attended evaluation work in different subjects and produce them before the Local Inquiry Committee(LIC) for verification at the time of visit.
8. During vacation, it is mandatory for teachers to undertake theory valuation and practical examination related works assigned by the University. Otherwise disciplinary action will be initiated for dereliction of duty, in the case of University, Government, and Aided College teachers and in the case of Unaided colleges attending to the examination work is one of the conditions to continue the Affiliation of such colleges.
9. Submission of any required documents after the date of approval will not be considered.
10. Wherever Bio-Metric attendance is implemented, the principals are requested to take permission from the Higher Authorities to waive of the requirement of attendance of the teachers on the days of the examination related work in the University especially during the evaluation of answer books.
11. The marks cards issued by NWAC, USA Diploma certificate is not considered as equivalent to 12<sup>th</sup> standard for admission to UG courses.
12. The colleges have to collect and remit the fee as prescribed by the University.
13. The Principals are requested to adhere to the above schedule of calendar of events and strictly follow the Rules and Regulations which are in force.

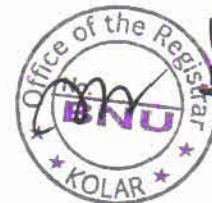

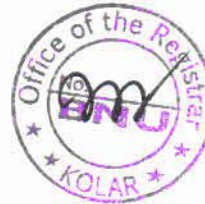
