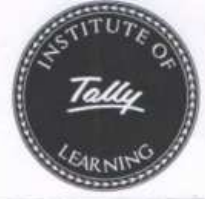



ARTICLE 2: CONDITIONS AND ARRANGEMENTS

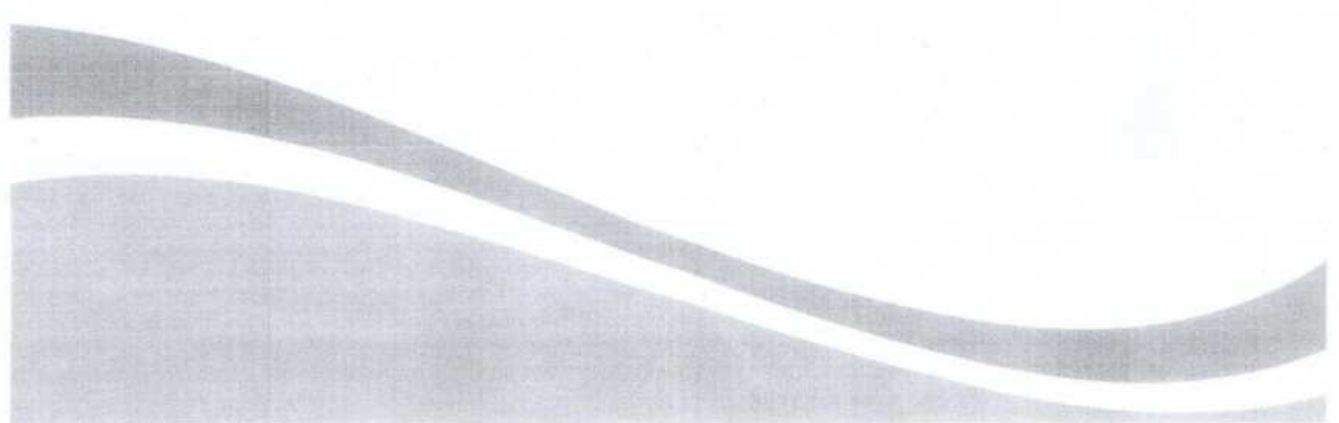
- ✓ Rats Technologies will require 50% amount for any type of training in 1st week of commencement and Remaining 50% amount after completion of training in following stages.
