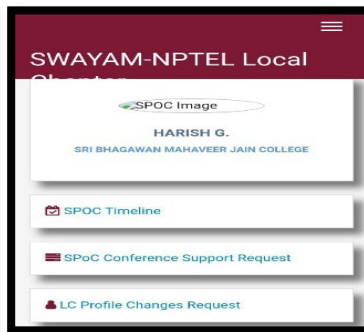
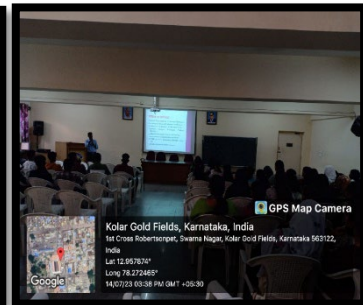
14th July 2023



The IQAC Cell in association with Computer Science organized National Level Webinar on the topic: Intellectual Property AI and ML on 26th May 2023

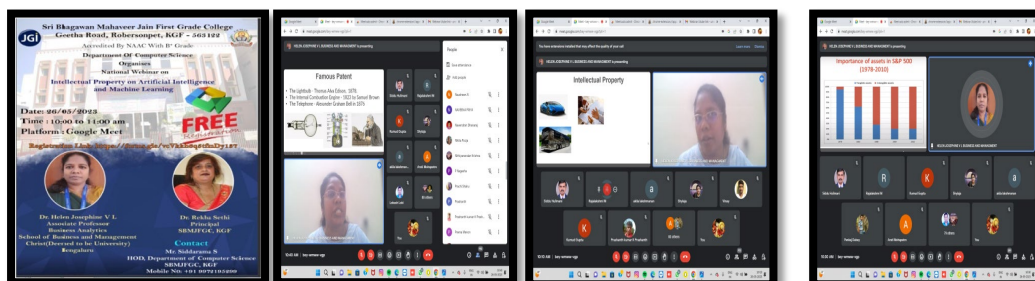

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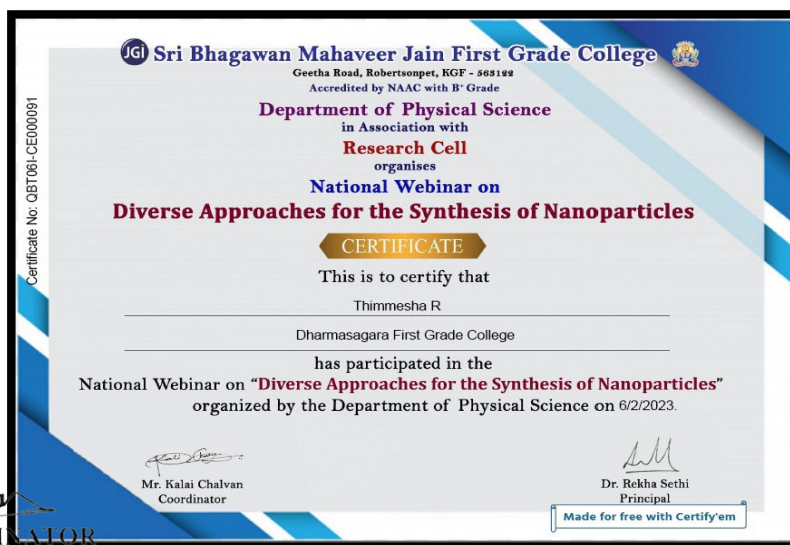
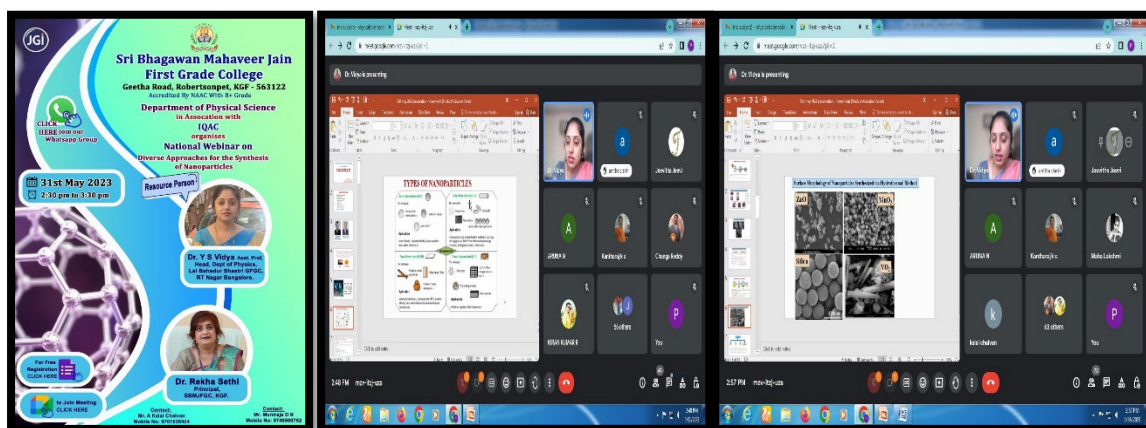


National Webinar

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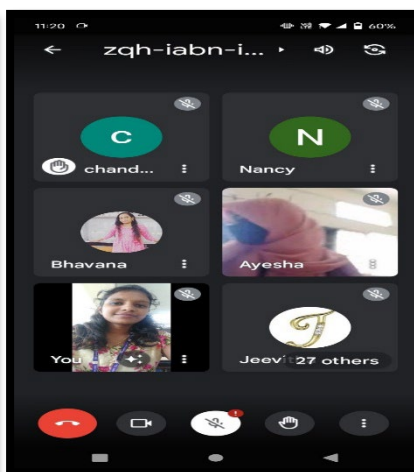
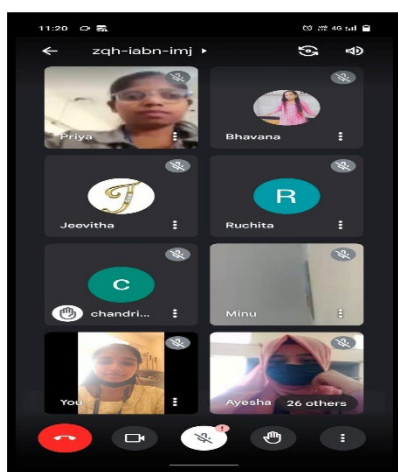
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National Webinar ON Strategies to Crack Competitive Level Examination after Graduation
